



## **Privacy Policy of WFC2008 5<sup>th</sup> World Fisheries Congress**

The Organizing Committee of WFC2008 5<sup>th</sup> World Fisheries Congress (“Organizer”) recognizes its obligation to safeguard personal information. Moreover, in response to the expectations of participants and other concerned parties (“Participants & Others”), the Organizer has established the following Privacy Policy as part of its commitment to ensuring the security of the personal information it has collected from Participants & Others (“Personal Information”).

- The Organizer shall use Personal Information only for the following purposes related to WFC2008 5<sup>th</sup> World Fisheries Congress (“Congress”):
  - ✓ to register participants
  - ✓ to contact and mail publications to Participants & Others
  - ✓ to compile a list of participants
  - ✓ to prepare name tags
  - ✓ to accept abstract submissions
  - ✓ to publish a book of abstracts
  - ✓ to present and manage the Congress.
- The Organizer shall not use Personal Information for purposes other than those stated above without the consent of Participants & Others.
- The Organizer may disclose Personal Information to a third party only in the following cases:
  - ✓ where the Participants & Others consent to the disclosure
  - ✓ where disclosure is required by law
  - ✓ where an official agent of the Congress guides the Participants & Others hotel accommodations
  - ✓ where the Organizer has commissioned the preparation & management of the Congress to a third party (“Contractor”) that is subject to a non-disclosure agreement.

The Organizer has commissioned the presentation & management of the Congress and the handling of Personal Information to the following Contractor.
